

Leading with Vision: Mr. Dilip on Bridging the Skill Gap in Exhibitions

India's exhibition industry is growing quickly, but its success depends on having a skilled workforce. According to Mr. Dilip Chenoy, who has extensive experience with the National Skill



Development Corporation (NSDC), it's important for the government, private companies, and educational institutions to work together to close the skill gap in the industry. To help young professionals gain the right skills, industry-focused certification programs, practical workshops, and hands-on training are needed. Including exhibition-related courses in schools and

colleges can also help prepare future professionals.

At the Annual General Meeting (AGM) held on September 28, 2024, Mr. Dilip, Secretary General of the Bharat Web 3 Association, delivered an insightful speech on the need for enhanced skill development in the exhibition industry. He emphasized that the success of exhibitions hinges on "execution," underscoring the importance of training individuals to carry out tasks effectively. He stated that knowing how to manage events efficiently is key to achieving success in this industry.

Mr. Dilip also suggested creating a detailed map of the different job roles in the exhibition industry. This map would outline the specific skills needed for each role, and help ensure proper training is in place. A clear structure would allow people to be better prepared for their jobs, whether they are working in logistics, event planning, or on the exhibition floor.

He also emphasized the importance of attracting young talent to the exhibition industry. He mentioned that organizations like CII and FICCI encourage youth participation, and he believes that the exhibition sector should do the same. Bringing in younger generations would lead to new ideas and fresh energy, which are important for the future.

The exhibition industry is also becoming more digital, especially after the pandemic. Hybrid exhibitions that combine physical and virtual platforms are now a key part of the industry's future. To keep up, professionals need to be trained to handle both physical and virtual event setups.

India has the potential to become a leader in the global exhibition industry, but this will only happen if it invests in skill development. By working together, the government, businesses, and educational institutions can help build a skilled workforce that meets international standards. Encouraging younger generations to join the industry, while also focusing on continuous learning, will help India unlock its full potential in the exhibition sector.

Chennai Air Show Tragedy: Lessons in Effective Crowd Management

The tragic deaths at Chennai's recent air show, where five lives were lost and over 100 people were hospitalized, underscore the critical need for effective crowd management strategies at large events. Despite the overwhelming excitement that drew an estimated 12-13 lakh attendees—far surpassing initial projections—the lack of a solid crowd control plan led to chaos during dispersal, resulting in heat exhaustion and fatalities.

To prevent such tragedies, effective crowd management must be prioritized in event planning. Here are key strategies for successful crowd management:

1. Comprehensive Pre-Event Planning:

Anticipate potential turnout based on marketing efforts and social media buzz. Conduct risk assessments and develop scalable infrastructure to accommodate large crowds.

2. Designated Exit Strategies: Create multiple, clearly marked exit routes to facilitate the orderly dispersal of attendees. Prioritize pathways for vulnerable groups, such as children, the elderly, and those with disabilities, to ensure their safe exit.

3. Public Transport Coordination: Collaborate with public transport authorities to increase service frequency and capacity during and after the event. This ensures that attendees can leave promptly and reduces congestion on streets and access points.

4. On-Site Amenities: Provide adequate facilities such as water stations, shaded areas, and medical assistance to address health concerns, especially in extreme weather conditions.

5. Real-Time Communication: Utilize loudspeakers, digital displays, or mobile

apps to communicate with attendees about crowd flow and safety instructions. Clear messaging can guide attendees effectively and prevent panic.

6. Crowd Monitoring and Control: Deploy trained personnel to monitor crowd behavior and dynamics throughout the event. Use barriers and physical guides to direct foot traffic and prevent bottlenecks.

7. Post-Event Review: Conduct a thorough analysis of crowd management effectiveness after the event, identifying areas for improvement and refining plans for future gatherings.

Implementing these strategies can help ensure the safety of attendees and create a positive experience during large-scale events, preventing the tragic outcomes seen in Chennai.
